AN IMPORTANT REMINDER ABOUT THE PASSOVER

- 42 It is a night of solemn observance to the LORD for bringing them out of the land of Egypt. This is that night of the LORD, a solemn
- observance for all the children of Israel throughout their generations. **43** And the LORD said to Moses and Aaron. "This is the ordinance of
- the Passover: No foreigner shall eat it. 44 But every man's servant who is bought for money, when you have circumcised him, then he may eat it. 45 A sojourner and a hired servant shall not eat it.
- 46 In one house it shall be eaten; you shall not carry any of the flesh outside the house, nor shall you break one of its bones. 47 All the congregation of Israel shall keep it. 48 And when a stranger dwells with you and wants to keep the Passover to the LORD, let all his

males be circumcised, and then let him come near and keep it; and he shall be as a native of the land. For no uncircumcised person shall

eat it. 49 One law shall be for the native-born and for the stranger who dwells among you." 50 Thus all the children of Israel did: as the LORD commanded Moses and Aaron, so they did. 51 And it came to pass, on that very same day, that the LORD brought the children of Israel out of the land of Egypt

REFLECTIONS

Last week, we learnt from Exodus 12:29-51 about how the Passover took place, and the result of it. The fulfilment of the Lord's Promises made to the children of Israel is also clearly seen in the sparing of their firstborn and their exodus from Egypt.

The Striking of the Firstborn in Egypt

The Lord's Power was seen in the final plague, where He struck the firstborn of all in Egypt, from the Pharaoh to those in the dungeons, and the livestock. Not a single house was spared from this plague, and there was a great outcry from the Egyptians.

The Exodus from Egypt

The children of Israel were given farewell presents of gold, articles of clothing, and silver from the Egyptians. More than 600,000 people left Egypt, and an important reminder of the Passover was given to the children of Israel. Whoever partakes of the Passover must be circumcised, in order to show his faith and his belonging to Israel.

Lessons Learnt

From this lesson, I have been reminded of the Purpose, Promise, Plan and Power of the Lord, seen evidently throughout chapters 3 to 12 of Exodus - from the Lord's promise to the Children of Israel to bring them out of the afflictions of Egypt being fulfilled and recorded in Exodus 12, to the Lord's Power seen in the ten plagues set in Egypt.

The Lord's Presence in leading Moses to speak to the people was constant, and it is a reminder to me too, that the Lord is there for me even as I face challenges in life.

This year, I have found myself falling sick often and missing school, causing me to miss out on lessons and fall behind. There have been many instances when I felt like giving up, and felt that catching up with the large amount of content was impossible. However, the Lord reminds me that He is always with me by sending people who have provided me with the support and encouragement that I needed to keep going. This reminder helped me to learn to draw strength from the Lord, and seek Him in times of tiredness and struggle through prayer.

This lesson is also a reminder that the struggles I face now are all a part of His plan to help me grow stronger in faith, and I must trust in Him. I am encouraged by this lesson to apply what is learnt from Psalm 111 – to praise the Lord with all my heart, to study and remember His works.
