TESTIMONY

O Give Thanks to the Lord

As I look back on 2023, I see the Lord's hand of goodness in my life.

4 June 2023. A Sunday that began ordinarily enough. Sunday School had ended and Morning Worship Service had just commenced. Looking at the two young men chairing the Service, I realised I could not see the left eye and part of the face of one of them. I shifted my focus to the other chairman and found that I similarly could not see his left eye and part of his face! When it came to singing hymns, I looked at the lyrics projected on the screen and realised that the right end of each line of lyrics had disappeared from view! I covered my left eye to see just with my right eye and the partial vision loss was still there. Covering my right eye and seeing with my left eye did not change the outcome. I felt this was abnormal but carried on in the worship service anyway. After about 15-20 minutes, the symptoms resolved and my vision was fully restored.

Since things returned to normal, I did not give the incident much further thought except that I should perhaps get a referral some time to see an eye specialist. A whole week passed and I took no action regarding what had happened. The following Sunday, I ran into Dr Elaine Tan and took the opportunity to tell her about my symptoms. I asked to see her during the week for a referral to see an eye specialist. She strongly advised me to go to the A&E as soon as possible in case it was a transient ischaemic attack (TIA). There was a tone of seriousness and urgency in her voice. I thought it

rather strange to go to the A&E one whole week after the incident. Nevertheless, I deferred to her medical expertise and went that afternoon to Tan Tock Seng Hospital A&E. I mentally prepared myself for a very long wait.

At registration, I told them I had temporary loss of vision. Within 2 minutes, they called me in for triage and was then brought to Ambulatory Urgent Care. Within 8 minutes, I was called in to see the doctor. There was no long wait like I had expected. Apparently they were treating me as a true emergency case, allowing me to skip ahead of the long queue of other patients.

The doctor tested my field of vision and eyesight. Both were fine. He thought it could be a TIA. He told me he would treat me as having had a minor stroke and ward me in order to run the necessary investigations.

I was taken in for an MRI. I was also then sent to see the eye doctor, who turned out to be Dr Elvine Neo from Bethany. He was very kind and reassuring. To meet a familiar face in a strange hospital setting where I was subjected to so many tests was just so good and heartwarming. He checked my eyes thoroughly and found no issues.

I was warded in EDTC (Emergency Department Therapeutic Care) Ward. The staff treated me like a stroke patient, asking me whether I had numbness or headache, whether I knew where I was and who I was speaking to. The MRI report released the next morning showed no abnormality of the brain and, as such, I was discharged.

According to medical studies, about 1 in 3 people who has a TIA will eventually have a stroke, with about half occurring within a year

after the TIA. Often called a ministroke, a TIA can serve as both a warning of a future stroke and an opportunity to prevent it. Patients are therefore advised to seek immediate medical attention when a TIA occurs so that potentially treatable conditions can be promptly identified and evaluated to help prevent a stroke.

On hindsight, I had not done the right thing by being so indifferent to my symptoms and only seeking medical attention a whole week after the event. I exercised regularly and had not considered that I could be a stroke patient. To think I actually had a ministroke! Things could also have been much worse. I could have suffered a major stroke in the interim period before seeking medical attention. I thank God for sparing me from that.

I want to thank Elaine and Elvine for their medical expertise and invaluable help.

I'm reminded again of how transient our life on earth is, and of how we must live for the Lord while we can.
